While HSP is honored to be invited to participate in this activity, it is important to recognize that we are guests as well of the "Host Facility", and as such, we must be able to guarantee that adequate supervision is going to be provided by your group to ensure the safety of all, and minimize the impact on business at the clinic. We ask that only members of the group attend the tour. Please, no siblings, relatives or friends. Additionally, no parents except those that are group leaders.

Additionally, as a very small group of volunteers with limited time and resources to devote to our various needs, HSP asks that the coordinator of your group contribute a small summary of the day's events and activities, including a few photos that can be submitted to the local media to generate public interest and exposure for HSP and your group's interactions. As a not-for-profit group that relies on community support to continue our work, this sort of follow-up is absolutely essential for our very survival.
